



Off-licence

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Lynfer Estate Ltd** is authorised to sell alcohol from the premises situated at **244 Dakins Road, RD7 MASTERTON** and known as **Lynfer Estate**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

CONDITIONS This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day. Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours: **Cellar Door - Monday to Sunday from 11.00am to 5.00pm.**
2. The delivery of alcohol sold by remote sale is not to be made between the hours of 11.00pm and 6.00am the next day.
3. Potable drinking water is to be freely available to customers while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises and signage directing people to drinking water must be prominently displayed on the premises at that time.

DESIGNATED AREAS - the whole of the premises is supervised.

RESTRICTIONS:

The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed.

The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that they sell by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age.

Duration: Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) Until its expiry date detailed below; OR
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence expires, until the close of the period 3 years after the expiry date.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence expires on:
