

Lynfer Estate Ltd Host Responsibility Policy

At Lynfer Estate we believe we have a responsibility to provide a cellar door environment that is comfortable and welcoming where wine can be sampled, enjoyed and purchased responsibly within the requirements of the Sale & Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.

In order to achieve this we have developed the following Host Responsibility policy.

Cellar door visitors who are visibly intoxicated will not be served alcohol and will not be sold wine for consumption off premise. They will be requested to leave the premises provided a safe transport option is available. If not, they will be encouraged to go for a walk and spend some time by the river until it is safe to drive.

We encourage visitors to our cellar door to have a designated driver.

It is against the law to serve alcohol to minors. If we are in doubt about someone's age, we will ask for identification. Acceptable forms of proof of age are:

- a current New Zealand driver's licence,
- an 18+ Evidence of Age card,
- a Kiwi Access card
- a current passport.

We will not encourage or promote the rapid consumption of alcohol or consumption of an excessive volume of alcohol.

We will not promote significant discounts or specials.

We will promote the responsible enjoyment of the virtues of wine.

Our policy is zero tolerance for aggressive, coercive or violent behaviour.

Chilled water is available free of charge at all times.

Visitors to our website are very welcome; however, before placing an on-line order the purchaser must verify they are over the legal age of 18 years to purchase alcohol.
